- **Lisa Johnson**, Realtor and business owner, Donnelly

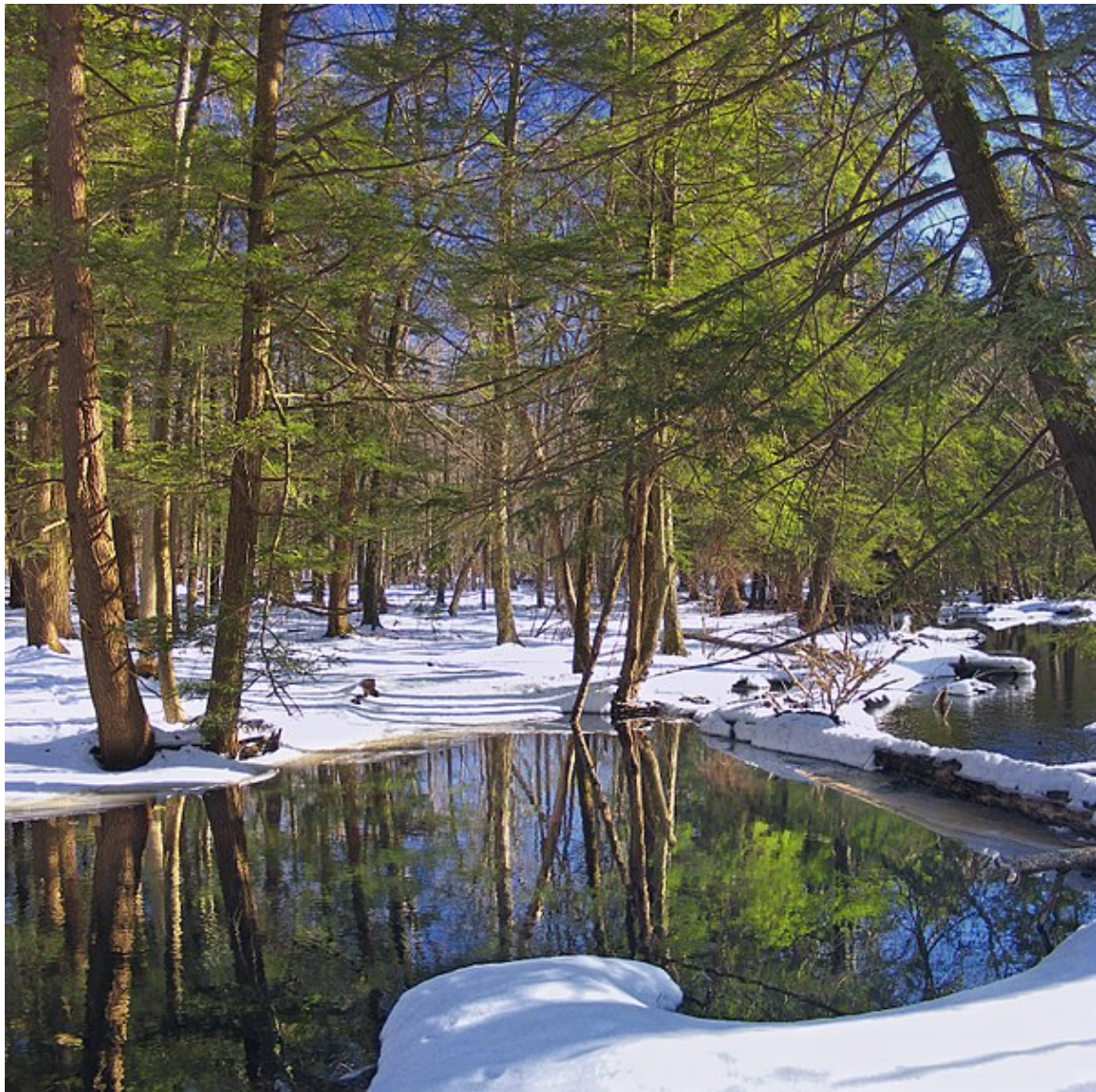
